

1. (3 pts) Print and hand in the following: Class Rules, Make Up Policy, POW Rules.
2. (14 pts) Answer each of the questions below. These are commonly asked questions. All answers can be found on the website. Each question is worth one point. You should print this sheet and write your answers directly on the sheet.
  - A. Can the Problem of the Week be turned in during class on the day it is due? **No. It is due at 8:00 AM.**
  - B. If at the end of the first quarter you have accumulated 436 points, what grade can you expect to receive for the quarter? **B+**
  - C. You must be absent on September 8<sup>th</sup> due to a college visit. Can you turn in the POW on September 10<sup>th</sup> for credit? **No. It is still due September 8<sup>th</sup>.**
  - D. You must be absent on September 8<sup>th</sup> due to a college visit. When should you expect to take Quiz 2.1-2.4? **Thursday, September 9<sup>th</sup> during class.**
  - E. You are absent on September 22<sup>nd</sup>. When should you expect to take the Chapter 2 Exam? **Thursday, September 23 with everyone else.**
  - F. What are Mr. Aiu's office hours? **M-F 7:15 – 8:00 AM, 4A, 4B, 5A, 5B; M, W, Th 2:37 – 3:00 PM**
  - G. Can you work on other (non-math) homework during cleanup days? **No**
  - H. What is the penalty for looking at or working on the POW during class? **A grade of 0 on that POW.**
  - I. When is the Chapter 5 Exam? Do you need to bring your calculator on that day? **Tuesday, November 23<sup>rd</sup> – Split Calculator, so yes**
  - J. What is the penalty for playing games on your calculator during class? **5 pts per occurrence, max 10 points per day.**
  - K. You have two more problems to finish on the Chapter 1 Exam when the bell rings. Can you come in later to finish the exam? **No, all assessments are to be completed in one class period.**
  - L. What is the penalty for continuing to work on an assessment after the bell rings at the end of class? **Automatic 10% penalty on the assessment**
  - M. When can you start working on the POW due 9/2/10? **Thursday, August 26<sup>th</sup>**
  - N. While working on the Chapter 1 Exam, your calculator gives you an answer of 23.46951237. What should you write for a final answer to that problem? **23.470**
3. (8 pts) Fill an 8.5 x 11 piece of paper (**hotdog style/landscape**) with things that describe you. Here are some guidelines:
  - The ONLY requirements will be:
    - Your First Name and Last Name must be there in AT LEAST TWO INCH LETTERS. (2 pts)
    - The Period (7) should be placed in the lower right corner (1 pt)
    - Completed landscape/hot dog style (1 pt)
    - All pictures/words/etc. must follow the rules outlined in the parent/student handbook (1 pt)
    - The paper should be filled (2 pts)
    - Must fit in plastic protector cover (1 pt)
