REGISTRATION PROCEDURES

1. (if applicable) You must complete the Pre-Approval Form for Course Reimbursement and Lane Movement before you register for a PLS class to be considered for tuition reimbursement and lane movement. You can download this from from the Moraine Valley Intranet.
2. Once you receive approval (if applicable), call 1-866-PLS-CLAS (1-866-757-2527). You will need to leave a \$50 non-refundable deposit, with the balance due on the first day of class.
3. Once twelve people have registered for a particular class, you will receive a confirmation letter from PLS. If twelve people are not registered for a class 10 days prior to the first class, the class will be canceled and deposits refunded.
